SUMMARY OF DIRECT CHARITABLE ACTIVITIES:

Implemented a program to identify and train emerging youth ministry leaders in local urban, inner-city communities. During 2008, 64 participants from Chicago, Cleveland, Indianapolis, and Miami completed their final three months of training. In addition, 59 participants from Atlanta, Kansas City, Minneapolis, Phoenix, and San Diego completed the first 12 months of their 15 month training cycle. And finally, the selection process was completed for 69 new participants from Cleveland, Dallas, Miami, New York, Washington DC, and a co-hort from the national organization Youth for Christ to begin their training in 2009. The curriculum was delivered through national conferences and local workshops to benefit persons in leadership positions working with at-risk youth in their respective organizations and cities.
