How does the program work?

A child from Colombia or Perú visits your home for about 6 weeks to experience family life. Children are between 5 and 14 years old.

If you are interested in adopting the child, CHSFS helps you complete the process for adoption, and the child comes to live at your home permanently a few months later.



Since 1999, out of the 1300 children participating in the KIDSAVE Summer Miracles program, 1000 have been adopted from Russia, Kazakhstan and Colombia. Since 2006, KIDSAVE works with Colombia and Perú.

CHSFS has been doing adoptions from Colombia and Perú for 23 years. Our staff in the U.S. and in Colombia and Perú have broad experience and will guide you smoothly through the adoption process.
