And finally, the selection process was completed for approximately 56 new participants from Kansas City, Birmingham, San Antonio, San Diego and Paterson to begin their training in 2001. The curriculum was delivered through national conferences and local workshops to benefit persons in the leadership positions working with youth in their respective inner city.
