Report of Fact finding Mission on Displacement of

Children from Humla

1. Background

Châtdern from the various Village Development Committees in the Humal district are being serie to Sathmands and to different places in India. This has been happening for around 10 - 12 years with the aim to provide the châtdern with free education. This information was accurated in the threat week of December 2005. It was collisated by the participants of Humla who were taking part in the Training Of Trainers (TOT) for a participants of Humla who were taking part in the Training Of Trainers (TOT) for a long discussion in the program of TOT. UNICEF Humla also conducted a public hearing on these issues on the date by the 1st week of December, 2004. During the public hearing, it was found that more than 300 children from Humla had been sent to Katmandu and India. Almost all of the Cirls were being sent to India whereas the boys where being sent to Kathmandu.

The name of the organization, involved in the taking of children from Humla is Himler Ophan child development center, Dalla Badaqir Phadera (DB Phadera) is the Charges on of this organization. It is registered in the district administrating office of Humla. Newsex they do not have an Office or context pales in the Humla. It was found that the parents who want to send their children out of Humla have easy access to communications with DB Phadera. However, presents of children who have already been sent to Kamandu or India. If not it very difficult to contact or meet with DB Phadera concerning the whereabours or further information on their children.

2. Objective of Mission

The objectives of the fact-finding team were as follows:

- To collect the facts about the children being brought out of Humla
- To know the reasons for taking the children out of Humla.
- To find out the opinion of guardians involved.
- To know the procedure of bringing the children out.

 To know the initiatives taken by the local administration and their involvement in the process.

Methodology

The team carried this out as follows:

- Interview and discussion with concerned agencies and persons (CDO, LDO, Guardians, Secretary of VDC)
- Meetings (Village Facilitators, Villagers, Relatives of the children)
- . Informal discussion (In the tea shop, Market, School etc.)
- Collecting the documents and analysis from government, non-government institutions and guardians.

4. Limitation of the Mission

Hamia is in the far Northwestern region of Nepal bordering the Hamiatyas. Due to the location of the Hamiat district, the weather conditions during the wisters sensor are very hanh, sopping all transportation. When the team went to investigate in the region, snow whe beginning to fall. Because of this, they had only 4 days in which to conduct their mistion before it became too difficult to flight out. Children are brought from various VDC Societies I remote areas. Major Findings

The stem collected relevant documents from government offices such as the CDO and the Ween's Development Department. During the study, the term obtained some essential information from the guardians of the children and people's options about the sussessible of the collection from the guardians of the children and people's options about the sussessible of the collection of the government officials, guardians, secretaries of VDC, general people and village facilitator of UDC. Bredge in Village, the following information was collection.

- Children from various VDC's of Humla have been sent to Kathmandu and India.
- Coardians have no information regarding their children once they have been taken from Humbs

- The person who is taking the children out is taking money from guardians.
- No certificates had been taken from the school where children have studied in Humla.
- Government officials (like CDO, LDO, WDD) have not been informed about the current location or situation of the children that where taken.

- · Government officials had prepared false death certificates of alive parents.
- Himali Orphan child development Center (NGO bringing children out of Humla) has no office in Humla
- The person involved in bringing the children out of Humla did not want to meet the fact finding team, even at the request of the CDO.
- Sunsuli Border (Which is more that 200 KM, from Nepalganj Airport) has been used to send children into India, whereas Nepalganj Border is only 4 KM away from the Airport of Nepalguni, where the children come though from Humla.
- The names of some of the children have been changed and pseudonyms use However Local administration are providing approval of the use of pseudonym
- Guardians were asked for money when they wanted to meet their children
- Only a few children are able to meet guardians sometimes.
- · Guardians are not able to meet concerning organizations or individuals
- District administration office has been giving approval even though there is a lack of required documents relating to scholarship programmes mentioned in application.
- There is a lack of required documents relating to the scholarship of the children who have been taken.
- 20 children are in a waiting list in the CDO office (Humla) awaiting approval from the government authority.
- The information collected indicates that the organization conducting the taking of children from Humla is in direct violation of the constitutional and international convention of children's rights.

Facts collected through meeting with Facilitator

Study team members conducted the meeting with village facilitators of UNICEF who are working in rural remote area of Humla.

Village facilitators explained about the numbers of children being taken out of Humla and briefed the group about the relevant village development committees.

According to village facilitator of relevant villages. The following VDCs were mainly affected from the incidents:

- Chipra VDC-9 Children (3 gird, 6 boy)
- Muchu-24 children (12 boys, 12 girls)
- Simikot- 20 children (3 boys, 13 girl)
- Thehe 20 children (13 boys, 7 girls) Lali - 4 children
- Ray Gaunbeshi- 5 children

Apart from the above village development committees, there were also children from Shreenagr, Sekta, Dadafaya and Gale being brought out of Katmandu and India. This data was collected only based on direct information from the VF (village Facilitator) and there may be larger numbers of children being brought out, uknown to the current investigation. According to dala bahadur fadera, more than three hundred children have been sent to kathmandu and india. Village facilitators said that not all children had been seet to Kamandah but some of them are sent to India through the Sanaali border whereas hospitality looker seems more logical. Furthermore, only gives are being sere to India. Guardians of the children complained to Vt, that they were unable to meet their children or find out the stillarder of their children. This information is not transpareer. Daller sould the guardians, when they asked him about the children, that they have been admitulated to some removed school in Nationals such as galaxy, Line angels, puspenhist market and some schools which are established by foreign citizenship. 7. Meeting with the Guardians

Secondly, members of the mission had conducted the meetings with the guardians of the children formally and informally. Guardians had provided different accounts and experiences and information with the study team.

Hira Bahadur Shahi, Hildung, Simikot

Hira Bahadur Shahi informed the team that he was hoping to send his daughter, in the near future. Dal Fadera has asked him to raise a total of Rs. 10,000,00 (in order to send his Daughter out from Flumila). At present Hira has collected rupees 7 thousand and has a further 3,000 Rs to collect For DB. In accordance to him, his daughter, Amurupa is reading 2 class and she is 9 years old.

Dal Fadera informed him that the recommendation letter written by the VDC and CDO office will be sufficient to send his daughter to Chennai [Madrai] for studying, therefore further certification would not be necessary. DB further informed him that the employees and teachers are all women in the school that his daughter would go to.

Existing member of parliamentarian Rajendra Pandrey helped him to keep his child at a school in Bhaskaper. He further memberioned that he himself met his child once, two years app [2003]. But he has forgotien the schools name and place, since them he has not contacted or met his child, Khadag kurher informed the seant that before sending his child he had requested recommendation letters from the VDC and the CDO who had later granted him these documents, following Bis his child had been seen to Kalmarandu.

Bhai Bahadur, Thehe VDC

Puntu Rokaya, Thehe VDC, Humla

Panta also informed the toam that she had sent her 9-year-old daughter named Joga May Bokaya. However her daughters etal name was changed and she is now called Trus Bokaya. Purtus has been informed that her daughter is reading in class one in Chemai Madras. Inclus. Joe was sent in Panta III. 2000 (1) "Issuary 2004) by means of Dal Phadera. At the time of sending her daughter, 2000 Rupoes and a plain ticket to Nepalguij and been silven to Dal Phadera by Vinc.

Dal Phadera had managed communication (by telephone) between Puntu and her Daughter at that time someone was prompting her Daughter on what to say.

Befor sending her daughter, the CDO and the VDC provided the required recommendation letters to Dal Phadera. These documents where sent with the daughter to India.

Jasu Rokaya, Simikot

Recording to Jasu Rokaya, her disighter, Sarjias Rokaya, was sent with another child in spirillawg 2001 from Hunila. Dall Phalocae told her disupplare is reading at Michele Joh Identical Educational and Medical Institute at Chemnal Medicals, Dall Phadera gove Jasu a shoot is which her disuplare is standing in front of a school. Dall Phadera arranged jostact to her child on Paulsh 9, 2000 (24** Dec 2003). Dals Phadera also informed Styam folkaya (the finisher to visit his disulpatice during the month of Magh (Jaun*Peb 2005).

Dala Phadera further informed Jasu, that her daughter's name (Sanjita) had been changed o Sally: During the telephone conversation, Sanjita, requested to her mother to come and



value her. In the same way Bhall Rokaya (nothor of Jasu Rokaya) also said that her daughter's name had been changed from Nama to Rima. Expressing her concern that she was unable to meet or communicate with her daughter. Date Fladders had provided a photo or her daughter. After sending their daughters a law presend justel Bit at close with Dalf Pladders to Hinnik. Junell was introduced to the guardians as the teacher of the school in Indias where their children had been sent. The economicalisate letter from the VIDC and the CDO had gone with the children with the c

When the team asked the Guardians how much money they had given, for their child to be taken from Humla, they where not willing to clarify the actual amount given to Dala Phadera. However they told the steam that they had given money for travel expenditure and the plain ticket to Nepalganj.

While talking to the local people it was established that the guardians had paid more to Dala Phadera than what they where telling the team.

Bir Man Sumar, Thehe, VDC

Bir Man Sunar informed the team, that he also sent his two sors, named Kurmes Sunar and Bisso Sunar with Dalla Bahadur Phaders to Kathmandu new seeks ago. He spent Rs. 20 thousand at that time. He expressed that he wanted to contact his soins but he was denied, he was given no information and is confused and irritated. Later he wants to go to Kathmandus to find out information about his soon.

Bikram Bhandari, Thehe VDC

Bizzen Bhundari Informed the team that his son (Machche Bhandari now changed to Mantsh) was serie yours ago (Diach 1980) with Kall Bahadur Bhundari flom Hunla to the Kimimok. Ram Bahadur and Gam Singh where 2 other children also seen with Machche Bhandari Change also now missing however the team off don ones with their parents. Once in Katmandu. From Katmandu, Machche was <u>sent to a foreign country though Bal Mandig Ph</u>is information was relayed to Bikram , 3 years ago (Date: 2001) by a member of Bal Mandir when Bikram came to Kathmandu looking for his son.

When Bikram came to know that his child was sent to another country he reqested to meet with his son but the staff of Bal Mandir said that Bikram had to pay Zlack rupies for this to be arranged.

Sikram explained to the team that the <u>CDO and VDC had prepaired a recommendation</u> etter stating that Machche Bhandari's (Bikrams son) parents where <u>Dead</u>. This was false

Only Kali Bahadur had the information on Bikrams son, however Kali is now dead and Chakra dose not know the information so there is no way of finding out about the child.

The guardians only have one photo of Harka. They are all extremely worried about Harka.

8. Meeting with VDC Secretary

9. Consultation with CDO

This research group discussed in depth, the issues in question, with the Chief District Officer Kinhar Pauled of Huntia District on the 31° December 2004 at the office of CDO. He informed the term that he has regularly given recommendation letters concerning the chiefens to Dala phadera to assist in their movement, after the completion of the overall process. Kinhar Parasa doned that the parents of the chiefen being sent in

This Fact finding team informed Krishna that the guardians of the displaced children want to meet their children. Krishna said that no complaints or grievances had been made know to him from any guardians about the meeting or concern of the children who had telt flumia.

This was some because Krishna had been applied by Dala Phadera so prepare the final letter of recommendation for these 20 children (the final stage in the recommendation process). In the application letter, Dala Phadera had mensioned about scholarship provided by Michel 26 Memorial Institute (Tami Madu, India) for free education to the girds, however there is no relievant documents stateful of the application.

familia is a remote Himalayan district of Nepal which is backward in various aspects. Due to the hands conditions of the land, poverty and illiteracy, life is very difficult for the subshittens district. Some person/organization including Himala Arash Ball Biassendra' are bringing many children out from Humla. To stop the process of saking of hidden from Humla is a very difficulty task and following challenges have been brought. to the attention of the fact finding team during this initial investigation in the district:

- · Poverty and illiteracy
 - lack of awareness of local administration
- . The peoples lack of awareness.
- No legal procedures have been adopted to know about the children sent out from Humla.
- There is no office established in Humla by the NGO involved in the movement and placement of the children from Humla.
- Many people suffering from various type of problem due to conflict have no alternative except sending their child out from district.
- All schools are closed due to conflict so the guardians believe they have no.

12. Conclusions

Most of the Guardians wish to meet with their children who have been sent out of Humla. They also wash to be informed about the situation of their children. Due to the circumstances and lack of information provided, the guardians are extremely worried and concerned for their children.

They are facing 'Mental Torture' because of it.

Data Bassuer Faders who is the president of Himal Orphan child Development Center is 3 younger border of Chalser Balander Fhaders, (e.v. store president of DDC Humá). 13. Recommendation

The Fact-finding team has given the following suggestions after the field visit:

- The real information should be provided to the guardians of the children who have been sent out of Humla.
- The overall process of placement of children (including scholarship program) should be transparent.

The government administration should initiate to make much responsible to such institution or person who are doing such works for providing the sufficient information of those children who have been already carried out from Hamla district, adopt the appropriate process by taking such serious consider-

Getting real situation of children, if it is found to have misused of those children, such institution and concerned person shall have to be punished in accordance to the law.

The recommendation process should be closed until and unless clear condition and status of children who have already been sent, will be provided.

Awareness program with the district administration officer, women development division, and other concerning institutions/persons along with guardians of potential children should be conducted.

Due to the number of children being brought by Dala phadera – information on the children's whereabouts and photos of the children should be collected so the correct information can be given to the parents. In addition, full profiles can be documented so no child is lots or forgotten.
