Dear Commission Jackson:



I am requesting everything the State has received from CNS in the last five years arising out of or having any connection with the Behavioral Pharmacy Management System.

To the extent electronic copies can not be made available, please provide them in hard copy format. However, I believe all of these were originally submitted in accessible electronic formats, so it should be a simple matter to make copies of them. If the cost to PsychRights will be more than \$100, please let me know in advance.
