We have a very active adoption program in Guatemala, on multiple fronts.

In addition to having assisted hundreds of families through the adoption process, we are now constructing an orphanage in the region of Zacapa, where 40 homeless children will be nurtured and cared for while they await placement into homes.

Typically, we place children into loving private foster homes or in small group homes called hogars.

At this time, we have infants through school age children that are available, and they are generally very healthy. Our staff makes frequent trips to meet the children, and talk to private attorneys who specialize in Americans adopting from Guatemala.
