INTERNATIONAL ADOPTION













In order to provide families with a wider variety of international adoption programs Christian Adoption Services, Inc. coordinates adoptions from China, India, Thailand, Ethiopia, Kazakhstan and Russia through World Association for Children and Parents, WACAP. Under this arrangement CAS provides direct services, specifically the home study, post placement services and re-adoption services while WACAP serves as the placing agency. As a Hague accredited agency, CAS works closely with WACAP to ensure the services provided are Hague compliant and address all requirements of USCIS, WACAP and the foreign country.

¹ Coordination Fee: Fees associated with Hague Accreditation, related insurance costs, and administrative support staff.

Many families will qualify for the adoption tax credit of approx. \$12,150 per child as created by the Hope for Children Act. Possible North Carolina adoption tax credit is 50% of the allowable tax credit claimed on your federal return.



² Post Placement Services: The fee is based on a maximum of three post placement visits/reports. If more than three visits are required, the remaining visits will be billed at the agency's current prevailing rate.

³ **Re-adoption:** CAS encourages all parents of international children perform this additional step. Re-adoption consists of two parts, filing the petitions and preparing a report to the court. While the petitions can be filed by the adoptive family or by an attorney, the report to court must be filed by a licensed agency.

⁴ Payment: All CAS fees and expenses are to be made payable to CAS via cash, check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard). Payments made via credit card are subject to a 2% processing fee.
